EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 10

**AN ORDER IMPOSING LIQUOR BAN IN THE ENTIRE
MUNICIPALITY OF SUYO, ILOCOS SUR DURING
THE ENHANCED COMMUNITY QUARANTINE (ECQ)**

- WHEREAS,** President Rodrigo Roa-Duterte issued Proclamation No. 922 on March 8, 2020 declaring the country under a State of Public Health Emergency due to Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19);
- WHEREAS,** under said directive, all citizens, residents, tourists and establishment owners were urged to act within the bounds of the law and to comply with the lawful directives and advisories to be issued by appropriate government agencies to prevent further transmission of the COVID-19 and ensure the safety and well-being of all;
- WHEREAS,** following the sharp increase in the number of confirmed COVID-19 cases throughout the country, the Office of the Executive Secretary has issued a Memorandum on March 16, 2020 and directed all heads of departments, agencies, offices and instrumentalities of the government, including the Philippine National Police (PNP), Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP), and the Philippine Coast Guard (PCG), GOCCs, GFIs, SUCs and LGUs to adopt, coordinate and implement guidelines on the imposition of an Enhanced Community Quarantine and the Stringent Social Distancing measures over the entire Luzon, including the National Capital Region (NCR) effective March 17, 2020 until April 13, 2020;
- WHEREAS,** upon the recommendation of the National Disaster Risk Reduction Management Council (NDRRMC) through Resolution No. 02, s. 2020, the President issued Proclamation No. 929 on March 16, 2020 and declared a State of Calamity throughout the Philippines due to COVID-19;
- WHEREAS,** all law enforcing agencies, with the support from the Armed Forces of the Philippines, were directed to undertake all necessary measures to ensure peace and order in affected areas, as may be necessary;
- WHEREAS,** in the exercise of the Inherent Police Power of the State, the government is expected to exercise reasonable control over persons and property within its jurisdiction in the interest of the general security, health, safety, morals and welfare except where legally prohibited;
- WHEREAS,** despite the strict home quarantine and stringent social distancing measures in force during this Enhanced Community Quarantine there are still reported incidences of liquor intoxication and small gatherings of individuals drinking liquor in certain areas within the bounds of the municipality;



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WHEREAS, in these times of national health emergency and state of calamity, it is imperative to control the sale, distribution and consumption of intoxicating substances to ensure peace and order and public safety, promote the health and general welfare of all inhabitants of the municipality;

NOW THEREFORE, I, MARIO B. SUBAGAN, Municipal Mayor of Suyo, Ilocos Sur, by virtue of the power vested in me by law and upon the recommendation of the members of the COVID-19 Municipal Task Force, do hereby order the following:

SECTION 1. LIQUOR BAN. The sale, distribution and consumption of intoxicating beverages such as beer, liquors, wines and the like are prohibited starting the date of effectivity of this order until the Enhanced Community Quarantine is lifted;

SECTION 2. PENALTY. Anyone found violating this Order shall be dealt with accordingly under the law.


Business establishments that willfully refuse to comply with this Order and to such other issuances and directives shall be ordered to close and/or its permit be suspended or revoked.

SECTION 3. SUPPLEMENTARY PROVISION. All policy guidelines and directives issued by the Office of the President, Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF) for the Management of Emerging Infectious Disease and its member agencies, other line agencies of the national government, Executive Orders of the Provincial Governor, local ordinances and resolutions and all other issuances related to the prevention, control and containment of COVID-19 issued or passed prior to this Executive Order and thereafter shall have supplementary application to this Order.

SECTION 4. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. In case any provision in this Order shall be declared invalid, illegal or unenforceable, the validity, legality and enforceability of the remaining provisions shall not in any way be affected or impaired thereby.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVITY. This Order shall take effect on this 3rd day of April 2020
